People's Loving Actions are the Fruit of the Spirit

The fruit of the Holy Spirit are the virtues of Christian life laid down by St. Paul in his letter to the Galatians.

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other (Galatians 5: 22-26).

Because we belong to Christ we should not be selfish so we should follow the Spirit. The purpose of our lives is to bear the fruit of the spirit by our actions. The Holy Spirit is the seed that produces the fruit in us. St. Paul encourages to walk by the fruit not by the flesh. You might be wondering how we can grow and produce the fruit of the Spirit. Here's some ideas:

- Stay close to God through prayer and consistent communication with Him
- Study and meditate of God's Word
- Stay connected in a Godly community



The more we engage in practices like suggested above the more room we make for the Spirit in our lives. Let's abide in Jesus and bear his fruit on the vine.
